# Air France to offer 33 weekly flights between Canada and France

## Toronto, February 28, 2018

Air France's 2018 summer schedule will include 33 weekly flights between Canada and Paris.

## **Toronto: 1 daily flight**

The Toronto-Paris route will be serviced daily during the peak summer season by Boeing 777-300 aircraft, with a capacity of 468 seats and enjoy the comfort of 3 travel cabins: Business, Premium Economy and Economy.

#### Montreal: 3 daily flights

In Montreal, Air France will return to its 3 flights a day from May 28 to the end of September. Air France customers' will have their choice of three summer departure times in Montreal: 5:10 p.m., 8:05 p.m. and 10:15 p.m.\*

\* From 18 June to 27 October, this flight will be operated with the B 787-900 Dreamliner.

#### **Ottawa: Daily shuttles**

Passengers coming from the federal capital continue to benefit from busses (2 Air France and 1 KLM) between the Ottawa bus station and the Montréal-Trudeau airport.

#### Vancouver: 5 flights/week

Weekly frequencies from Vancouver will go from 4 to 5 flights a week between June 9 and September 21 aboard a Boeing 777-200 offering the latest travel cabins.

#### Quebec: Daily shuttles (BQC) and flights (YQB)

The daily shuttle between the Ste-Foy bus terminal and Montréal-Trudeau airport will continue to simplify the travel experience for passengers departing from Quebec City, complete with free wifi on board and smooth connections with their Air France-KLM Group flights, at the same fares passengers departing from Montreal enjoy.

For customers preferring an air link, code-share flights with WestJet provide connecting opportunities on the Toronto and Montreal Air France and KLM flights.

# Air France and KLM in Canada

This summer, Air France & KLM will offer 70 weekly flights to Europe. Air France will offer 33 daily trips to Paris-Charles de Gaulle from Montreal (21), Toronto (7) and Vancouver International Airport (5) to which are added 37 KLM flights to Amsterdam: Montréal (7), Toronto (12), Calgary (7), Edmonton (4) and Vancouver (7).

# **New Flying Blue Programme**

Flying Blue, Air France-KLM's loyalty programme, is changing as from 1 April 2018 and will offer more simplicity and flexibility in the use of the programme, a clearer reward scale and more choice in the use of Miles. The cumulative number of Miles will now depend on the expenses and status of the members instead of honoring the distance traveled between the airport of departure and arrival aboard flights marketed by Air France (AF), KLM (KL), HOP! (A5) or Joon (JN).

For each euro spent, Ivory, Silver, Gold and Platinum members will receive 4, 6, 7 and 8 Miles respectively. Moreover, customers will be able to earn Miles when purchasing additional services such as an A la Carte Menu on board an Air France flight, additional baggage allowance, or reserving an Economy Comfort seat on a KLM flight. The balance of Award Miles as of 31 March 2018 will remain unchanged on 1 April 2018.

The Flying Blue and WestJet Rewards programs now offer reciprocal benefits to its cardholders who can earn miles while traveling on the other airline's flights; and also redeem these miles to travel on the partner's network.



# New at Charles de Gaulle

Charles de Gaulle just reopened a reinvented lounge in Hall L, which offers the possibility to passengers with a Flying Blue Elite Plus card to benefit from this space of 3200 m<sup>2</sup>. This lounge opened a first part of 2180 m<sup>2</sup> on January 25 and a second part will be unveiled in July 2018 with new inaugurated spaces.
