

## 1. THE SPIRIT OF PROVENCE & ITS HERITAGE

#### Succumb to the charm of this Provençal destination...

"Spirit of Provence" Such is the motto of our region, which describes all its facets: spirit of the family, spirit of the earth, spirit of adventure!

Roquebrune • Les Issambres • la Bouverie: a "Land of Plenty" on the Cote d'Azur where Provence displays everything it has to offer. The medieval village, a seaside resort, beaches, hills, gorges, forests, the Mediterranean... Half-way between Cannes and Saint-Tropez, this unspoilt countryside offers the best of the Midi.

The medieval village just off the main road reveals itself, telling its own story in quiet contemplation.

Once upon a time...an ancient village dominated by it "Rocher", a majestic rock.

Its church, its fountains, its porticos, and its many chapels bear witness to a rich past. . The old village has retained its narrow alleys and tiny

Provençal squares that give it a typically Provençal charm.

Not to be missed is the parish church with its remarkable architecture and painted interior that earned it a listing in the Inventory of Historical Monuments in 1987.

#### A Museum rich in history: Maison du Patrimoine

## 2. Enjoy the Maison du Chocolat et Cacao

#### An unusual museum ... La Maison du Chocolat et Cacao

There have once been places full of history whose purpose has shifted somewhat. A specific example of this is right in the centre of the Provençal village of Roquebrune-sur-Argens where a former chapel has been converted into the "Maison du Chocolat et Cacao". In 1635 Saint-Jacques hospice, rue de l' Hospice was formally recognised. It was a work of charity whose purpose was to care for the sick.



The hospice was closed in 1892 and the chapel which was initially abandoned for some years, has become the home of Roquebrune's local museum.

There are now almost 1,000 items on display. These include an ancient hot chocolate pot dating back to 1798, Nicolas DEMERY's "Universal Pharmacopoeia" dating back to 1697, or indeed the only BANANIA clockwork figure of the two recorded as being in France that is in working condition.

#### A COLLECTION AWAITING DISCOVERY!

The museum has a rare collection of items of all kinds: snack boxes, BANANIA tins, hot chocolate pots, enamel plaques, advertising posters, collectable cars for advertising purposes, toys, cocoa tins... original and unprecedented chocolate sculptures created by the three chocolate makers from the village. #### 4. Fun on the water

#### A lake, a river, the Mediterranean...your choice!

Unique in Provence and the Cote d'Azur: three different aquatic settings in the same locality, all of them are open to everyone and offer a wide range of water-based activities. Wild coves, coastal path, thalassotherapy, Gallo-Roman fish pond, panoramas and beautiful views, catamaran cruises, the lake, fly boarding, sea karting, canoeing...

#### Les Issambres, the charms of an unspoilt coastline

Over 14 km of coastline alternating between rocky inlets, secret coves, small harbours and fine sandy beaches. Difficult to better this - especially as all the water sports activities on offer are set quite simply against this beautiful backdrop. Les Issambres has the smell of the Mediterranean and keeps the secret of the local fishermen's stories.

#### ✓ Not to be missed

The Roman Fish Pond. It is thought that it was constructed at the end of the 1st century of our era. Bearing witness to the Romans' keen interest in fishing, fish farming and trading, it was listed on 25th May 1939 in the Inventory of Historical Monuments. The panoramic viewpoint and the chapel of the dolmens.





#### The River Argens and Lake Perrin ...: a place to take your breath away

More than 30 hectares of fresh water at the foot of the legendary Rocher de Roquebrune, Lake Perrin is one of the most beautiful places on the Cote d'Azur. Relax in a pedal boat or a canoe, fool about on the tow tube or, for those who love a thrill, skim the water on water skis.






## 6. Venturing into the heart of nature

#### NATURAL HERITAGE

Enjoy a nature conservation area as you ride the Cantons of Palayson mountain-bike circuits; this nature reserve is a listed NATURA 2000 site, or even walk the footpaths on the "Rocher", a listed area of national interest, which sores above the approaches to the village, or along the exceptional Gorges of the River Blavet, carved out of the volcanic rock...



#### La Bouverie

In a natural setting to the north of Roquebrune-sur-Argens, La Bouverie is a favourite location to explore and spend your leisure time. Amongst stone pines and eucalyptus trees, you can explore the Palayson forest. You can set off to roam the trails and discover some enchanting spots. All you have to do is choose... on horseback, walking, or on a mountain bike?

Further on, you reach the Gorges of the River Blavet, a natural boundary with the commune of Bagnols en Forêt, a favourite place for those who like rock climbing...

At the bend in the track, the wooded setting gives way to a panorama of Provençal vineyards where the sun blessed grapes offer the promise of excellent local wines.
