





The Walter-Guillaume Collection

The intellectual project of the tradesman Paul Guillaume and his wife Domenica. the Walter-Guillaume Collection is a unique collection that illustrates the creation of the first decades of the 20th century, based around works which are representative of impressionism and modern classicism. In the collection, masterpieces of Renoir, Cézanne, Modigliani, Le douanier Rousseau, Laurencin, Matisse, Picasso, Derain, Utrillo et Soutine.



Located next to the Champs-Élysees, the residence of Édouard André and Nélie Jacquemart exhibits one of the finest private art collections in Paris, with the atmosphere of a large 19th century mansion house.

orld Heritage site for 30 years, the château of Versailles is one of the finest achievements of 17th century French art and architecture. Louis XIII's former hunting lodge, transformed by his son Louis XIV, became the seat of the French Court and government in 1682. Until the French Revolution, his successors improved the château in their turn. The garden, designed by Le Nôtre, is still the model formal French garden - the 'bosquets' provide real rooms of greenery and the many long perspective views seem to stretch to infinity. In the park, there are two châteaux to visit: the Grand Trianon, constructed in 1670, and the Petit Trianon with its grounds, given in 1774 by Louis XVI to Marie-Antoinette, the only gueen to have imposed her personal taste at Versailles. Since their restoration in 2008, the Trianon châteaux and Marie-Antoinette's estate have recovered their cohesion and now reveal the private life of the queen who lived a simple, country life within these walls




















MuMA **FINE ARTS MUSEUM ANDRÉ MALRAUX**

An exceptional glass and steel building facing the entrance to the harbour, the Musée d'Art Moderne André Malraux was the first large museum to be constructed in France in the postwar period. Originally a museum and cultural centre (France's first), it has since zeroed in on its role as a museum. The building itself is a masterpiece of modernity, characterised by transparency and lightness. Its collections were initially a reflection of the various schools of painting in Europe since the renaissance, but thanks to donations and legacies in the 20th century, these have developed into an important testimony to modern art. Its collection of impressionist art is second only to the Orsay in France, with major works by Monet, Boudin, Pissarro, Renoir, Sisley, Degas, Jongkind, among others, and it also has an important collection of Fauvist art (Dufy, Friesz, Derain, Van Dongen, Marquet, Camoin, etc.).

MONTIVILLIERS ABBEY

Montivilliers owes its celebrity to the prestigious women's abbey built there in 684. It was later destroyed by the Vikings and only rebuilt in the 11th century. There then followed a period of success and great influence, right up until the revolution, which was to sound its death knell. In the 19th century, it became a cotton mill, a sugar refinery and finally a breweru.

Now fully restored, visitors can follow the "coeur d'abbaye" tour around the monastery complex. This takes in the living quarters of the nuns: the cloister, the 13th century Gothic refectory, the chapter house, and the 12th and 16th century dormitories.





MAISON DU PATRIMOINE, **ATELIER PERRET**

Widely considered as one of the most significant projects of the 20th century, the reconstruction of Le Havre is truly exceptional. It was declared a World Heritage Site in 2005, commending the work of Auguste Perret. This master architect drew his inspiration from a combination of the classical style and a wish to modernise, reinventing the city with well-proportioned, harmonious architecture.

The plan for the town was based on innovative possibilities opened up by the use of concrete, the "21st century stone". Some noteworthy examples include the Porte Océane, the Place de l'Hôtel de Ville and its tower, and St Joseph's church.

Mr Jean-Marie Girault, With destruction wreaked across almost three quarters of this martyr city of the Liberation in the summer of 1944, Caen deserved a fitting tribute for the damage it suffered. And such a tribute was paid, but with the focus on what continues to be the Mémorial's running theme: reconciliation. This vocation, unique to the Mémorial de Caen museum, will guide you through the museum's different stages, taking you back over the 20th century. This chapter in global history opened in Sarajevo on 28 June 1914 with the assassination of Archduke Franz Ferdinand and partly ended on 9 November 1989 in Berlin with the "Fall of the "Wall".





THE CASTLE OF THE DUKES OF BRITTANY

A witness to the history of Nantes and of Brittany, the Castle of the Dukes of Brittany is an exceptional heritage site right in the city centre. This Breton fortress with its 15th and 18th century buildings testifies of the history of the city. Built by François II, the last Duke of Brittany, and continued by his daughter Anne of Brittany, twice Queen of France, the castle fortifications enclose a Renaissance palace with exquisitely carved façades and loggia. Inside the Dukes' palace is the museum of history with its contemporary displays. Because history isn't a static science, an entire new section has been created relating to the 20th century and more specifically to the First and Second World Wars.














MUSÉE SAINTE-CROIX

The Musée Sainte-Croix in Poitiers. located near the Saint John Baptistery and Poitiers Cathedral, is the leading museum in the Poitou-Charentes region due to the richness of its art and archaeology collections. The region's prehistoric period is represented by an exceptional collection of carvings from the La Marche cave. The Gallo-Roman Antiquity introduces visitors to the main town of the Pictones, under the protective gaze of Athena, a marble statue of outstanding quality dating from the 1st to 2nd century AD. Beautifully carved sarcophagi bear witness to the art of the Late Antiquity and the High Middle Ages. Series of sculptures illustrates the extraordinarily flourishing Roman workshops in the Poitou region.

The fine art collection includes works from the 14th century to contemporary art. The major artistic movements of the 19th century are all represented here

(Neo-classicism, Orientalism, Ingrism and Symbolism) and extend to a remarkable collection of seven sculptures by Camille Claudel and 3 more were acquired end 2017. Modern art from the beginning of the 20th century is brilliantly illustrated with paintings by Mondrian, Bonnard, Vuillard, Sisley, Marquet and more.




















CANAL DU MIDI & BASTIDE SAINT LOUIS AND CAVAYÈRE LAKE

The Bastide Saint Louis, built in the 13th century, destroyed by the Black Prince during the Hundred Year's War, and rebuilt afterwards, became a city very rich thanks to the profist from the draperies in the 17th century and the wine trade later. SITE ARCHÉOLOGIQUE LATTARA - MUSÉE HENRI PRADES

The Archaeological Museum of Lattes is situated close to ancient Lattara, an important port on the western Mediterranean. Located on the former delta of a coastal river, the Lez (Ledum Flumen), it was occupied from VI c. BC to III c. AD.

Built beside the excavations of the ancient port, the Archaeological Museum Henri Prades bears witness to the local daily-life of Antiquity.

The port of Lattara was active during more than 800 years, throughout which it was a place of economical and cultural exchange for the people who lived in the western basin of the Mediterranean (the Etruscans, the Greeks coming from Marseille, the Iberians, the Romans, etc.,) and the local celtic populations.

extensive and best preserved heritage of wooden buildings. Having almost disappeared entirely, this incredible collection of timber-framed houses from the Middle Ages and the Renaissance is now the pride of the whole city.

With 11 Catholic churches in its city center, Troyes and the Aube département are home to the largest collection of painted stained glass windows, an art form that gained popularity in the Middle Ages, in Europe. Influential scholars like Rashi and Bernard de Clairvaux made Troues one of the cradles of western thought in the Middle Ages.

Trouges dominated the knitwear production industry in France for more than a century. And nowadays, Troyes is known as the European capital of brand outlet centres. These outlet centres were once known as "factory outlets".
